Superintendent News...

Leaf collection (Spring pickup):

Leaves must be in bags. The village DPW will pick them up.

Brush pickup (Spring pickup):

Brush pickup will begin April 18, 2011 (weather permitting). If weather is bad on that date, brush pickup will be on the next sunny day!

The village will be renting a chipper. All tree butts must face the street and be stacked in an orderly fashion. If brush piles are not stacked properly, village employees will not pick them up. Brush will be chipped on the 15th of each month consecutively until November 1, 2011. Also, if you cut a large tree on private property, it is your responsibility to clean it up.

*** Please note the council recommends to keep the road right of way clear, please put brush out to the street on the 14th of the month. We prefer brush to be placed next to curb/street no more than 24 hours prior to the 15th of the month.

Tornado Whistle:

Tornado Warning: you will hear 3 (1 minute) blasts. When it's clear, you will hear 1 (1 minute) blast.

Tornado Shelter:

The basement of the Village Office, 115 E Evergreen St., in Sheridan will be available for Village residents during a Tornado Warning. At the present time, the basement is not barrier free. If you hear the tornado warning whistle, the basement will be available to take shelter. The Sheridan Fire Auxiliary is organizing these efforts.

Community Happenings...

- Recycling is the First Tuesday of the month from 10:00 - 4:00 weather permitting
- Notary Services are available for free at the Village Office
- The fire whistle should be up and running soon so we all know when it is 6 o'clock again! The Maintenance guys are working very hard trying to get it going for us :)



Reminders...

- The Village of Sheridan has an ordinance against burning leaves/grass clippings in the Village. Recreational fires are permitted in an approved pit and must be attended.

Dear Village Residents;

Cities, Townships and Villages in the State of Michigan are experiencing difficult economic times. The state has reduced revenue sharing payments; property tax revenues are declining due to lower property values and we are receiving substantially lower payments from the Department of Transportation for road maintenance.

The Village of Sheridan has only a limited amount of income. We must hold down our expenses, we must limit all non-essential services and cut necessary expenses to the minimum. Decisions being made by the Sheridan Village Council may not always be popular but are being made so you have a pleasant and safe village to live in.

Our most recent village improvement will be a new water well. The cost will be about \$150,000.00 and will greatly increase our water flow and our capacity during an emergency.

The Health Fair will be held on July 14th at the Sheridan Community Center from 2:00 - 5:00 pm

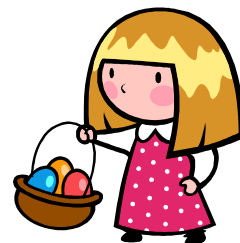
