



**REGULAR MEETING  
SHERIDAN VILLAGE COUNCIL  
JUNE 14, 2011**

The regular meeting of the Sheridan Village Council was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by President Susan Wyckoff-McFarland

Present: Harold Arrington, Curt Sisson, Don Nassif, Pete Gehoski

Sisson moved to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting with Gehoski supporting. Motion carried.

Council reviewed bills for the general fund. Motion to approve by Nassif, supported by Sisson. Motion carried.

Council reviewed bills for the wastewater fund. Motion to approve by Sisson, supported by Nassif. Motion carried.

Motion to approve Treasurer's Report made by Gehoski, supported by Nassif. Motion carried.

Officer Kotenko reported that SpringFest had gone smoothly and was uneventful for the officers which had an extra 112.5 hours at no additional cost to the Village of Sheridan. He also thanked the Sheridan Fire Department for assisting at a drowning recently. Stated that the Sherman St. residence that has been in violation of the junk ordinance has been reorganizing and cleaning out his garage and is making progress. He will also try to take care of Kellogg's property and a residence on the corner of Maple and Washington Streets that have a truck load of tires behind it.

Doug Lane presented the council with estimates to do Chip & Seal on Washington St., St. Clair St., and Pearl Lake Drive. The estimated total would be approximately \$18,087.00. Council discussed the condition of the different roads and listened to Lane's recommendations.

Ed Lingeman reported that the Community Center has been pretty active so far this season through the month of July.

Marcia Hersch announced that the Field Work for the Audit was done on June 6 & 7 by Gabridge & Company and that the audit should be finalized by the end of July.

Marilyn Klemm reported she is getting ready for the Village Taxes to be printed and mailed by the first of July.



Lane will get prices for new letters on the sign that is on the Community Center building because some of them are missing.

Wyckoff-McFarland discussed that there has recently been Jet Ski's on Pearl Lake again this summer. Hersch gave the Ordinance Committee the findings Ron Finegood had typed up last year that explains the steps involved with making the lake a No Wake zone. Kotenko explained that there are other State laws that the police would be able to enforce if the Jet Ski's were in violation. The matter will be discussed again at the July meeting.

Motion by Sisson to do the Chip & Seal on Washington St. (from Main to Maple), St. Clair St. (from Pine to Balderson) and Pearl Lake Dr (from Perry's to end of the cul-de-sac) for a cost of approximately \$18,087.00, supported by Arrington. All in favor. Motion carried.
