Superintendent News...

Leaf collection (Spring pickup):

Leaves must be in bags. The village DPW will pick them up.

Brush pickup (Spring pickup):

All tree butts must face the street and stacked in an orderly fashion. If brush piles are not stacked properly, village employees will not pick them up. Brush will be chipped on the 15th of each month consecutively until November 1, 2009. Also, if you cut a large tree on private property, it is your responsibility to clean it up.

- * Please note the council recommends to keep the road clear; please put brush to the street on the 14th of the month. We prefer brush to be placed next to curb/street no more than 48 hours prior to the 15th of the month, with an exception if the 15th falls on a weekend.

Tornado Whistle:

Tornado Warning: you will hear 3 (1 minute) blasts. When it's clear, you will hear 1 (1 minute) blast.

Tornado Shelter:

The basement of the Village Office, 115 E Evergreen St., in Sheridan will be available for Village residents during a Tornado Warning. At the present time, the basement is not barrier free. If you hear the tornado warning whistle, the basement will be available to take shelter. The Sheridan Fire Auxiliary is organizing these efforts.

Reminders...

- The Village of Sheridan has an ordinance against burning leaves/grass clippings in the Village. Recreational fires are permitted in an approved pit and must be attended.
- The Village of Sheridan has the opportunity to recycle on the 3rd Wednesday of each month at the Corner of Evergreen Street and M-66 (across from the Shell gas station) from 10 to 4 pm. Think Green!
