Superintendent News...

DPW WILL BE FLUSHING HYDRANTS ON OCT. 7TH AND 8TH.

Leaf collection (Fall pickup):

Leaves must be on the edge of the road for pick up. The village DPW will pick them up Monday, Oct. 19th through Fri. Nov. 20th

Brush pickup (Fall pickup):

All tree butts must face the street and be stacked in an orderly fashion. If brush piles are not stacked properly, village employees will not pick them up. Brush will be chipped on the 15th of each month consecutively until November 15, 2009. Also, if you cut a large tree on private property, it is your responsibility to clean it up.

Tornado Whistle:

Tornado Warning: you will hear 3 (1 minute) blasts. When it's clear, you will hear 1 (1 minute) blast.

Tornado Shelter:

The basement of the Village Office, 115 E Evergreen St., in Sheridan will be available for Village residents during a Tornado Warning. At the present time, the basement is not barrier free. If you hear the tornado warning whistle, the basement will be available to take shelter. The Sheridan Fire Auxiliary is organizing these efforts.

Reminders...

- The Village of Sheridan has an ordinance against burning leaves/grass clippings in the Village. Recreational fires are permitted in an approved pit and must be attended.
- The Village of Sheridan has the opportunity to recycle on the 3rd Wednesday of each month at the Corner of Evergreen Street and M-66 (across from the Shell gas station) from 10 to 4 pm. Think Green!
