

**REGULAR MEETING
SHERIDAN VILLAGE COUNCIL
APRIL 9, 2008**

The regular meeting of the Sheridan Village Council was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by President, Brian Russel.

Present: Daryl Bush, Harold Arrington, Susan McFarland, Doug. Abbott, Curt Sisson.

McFarland moved to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting and the annual meeting with Bush supporting. Motion carried.

Bills were presented in the amount of \$26,293.32. McFarland moved to pay them with Abbott supporting. Motion carried.

Bills for the wastewater treatment system were presented in the amount of \$2,522.50. McFarland moved to pay them with Arrington supporting. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report was reviewed. Sisson moved to approve the report with McFarland supporting. Motion carried.

Dep. Germaine requested overtime hours for the sheriff's department and also guards for traffic control during the Memorial Day springfest weekend. Council approved the same amount of overtime hours as last year.

Lane advised he had a bid of \$16,400. to tear down the old elevator and \$42,800. to tear down the elevator and remove the slab.

Discussion in regards to cleaning up the elevator property.

Lingeman gave the community center report. He also advised that he had been to a meeting in Howard City that morning and picked up a sheet showing Howard City's disposal service program.

Tissue reminded the council that the mobile recycling unit would be in the village next Wednesday. She also advised that the Montcalm Chamber of Commerce's Award Banquet will be April 24, 2008 at Clifford Lake. She also informed the council that the auditors would be here on May 19th and 20th.

Jackie Christensen from the Lady's Auxiliary requested that the village apply for permits from MDOT to close M-66 for the following Memorial Day activities:

May 24th from 2:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. for the classic car show with a back up date of May 25th in case of bad weather.

May 25th from 9:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. for the firemen's parade.

May 26th from 10:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. for the Memorial Day parade.

Also a permit to hang a banner.

Tim DeWitt from Carrier & Gable, Inc. gave a presentation on LED lighting and the cost savings and maintenance benefits.

Amendments were made on the "Request for Proposal" for the residential refuse collection which will be mailed to trash haulers for bids.

Discussion regarding the increase in the employees' health plan.

With no further business, McFarland moved to adjourn at 8:55 P.M. with Abbott supporting. Motion carried.
