SUPERINTENDENT NEWS:

Leaf collection (Fall pickup):

Fall pickup on leaves will begin the week of October 22, 2007, and continue until it snows (weather permitting). You do not have to bag the leaves in the fall. Please rake them to the curb and the village DPW will clean them up.

We do not normally pickup leaves with the leaf machine in the **spring**. Please be considerate and pile leaves and brush in two separate piles. **Spring Leaves need to be bagged.**

Brush pickup:

Brush pickup will be once a month in the fall. Weather permitting, the 15th of the month. All tree butts must face the street and stacked in an orderly fashion. Brush piles must be separate from leaf piles. The leaf machine will not pick up brush. If brush piles are not stacked properly, Village employees will not pick them up.

Note We prefer brush to be placed next to the curb/street no more than 24 hours prior to the pickup date.

Reminder** Homeowners are responsible for cleaning their own sidewalks in the winter.

Snow Plowing:

No parking on village streets from 2 am to 6 am. All vehicles must be moved off the streets and off the street right of way in order to keep the streets plowed.

Tree Trimming, cutting:

If you are planning on excessive trimming or cutting large trees on private property: please contact Doug Lane, Village Superintendent prior to cutting trees to see who is responsible for disposal of the tree(s). Disposal of trees is at the discretion of the Village Superintendent.
